

## Completed Bibliography Example

Below is what a completed bibliography should look like. Remember that it needs to be in alphabetical order by the author's surname/organisation responsible for the source. If there is no author then use the title of the source as the first part of the entry. If you can't find a date of publication, especially for a website, put n.d. (no date).
